# Stay Healthy this Fall: Get Vaccinated

Flu season typically starts in October and ends in May. AND unfortunately, COVID-19 is still with us. Get vaccinated to protect yourself and those around you from both viruses. Symptoms of flu and COVID-19 are similar, and infection can occur at the same time. Vaccines reduce the risk of severe illness and may prevent hospitalization and death. It is recommended everyone 6 months of age and older receive an annual flu shot and stay up to date on COVID –19 vaccines. Both shots can be given at the same visit.

In addition to getting vaccinated:

- · wash your hands frequently
- avoid touching your face
- cover your coughs and sneezes,
- · avoid crowds and poorly ventilated spaces
- clean commonly touched surfaces
- wear a mask when recommended
- and stay home if you're sick
